Records imported from RISM's printed volumes A/I (music by one composer published up to ca. 1800) and B/I (anthologies with music by multiple composers published up to 1700) are in Muscat.

Most of these imported records are in need of revision. RISM contributors are welcome to revise these records. Please observe the following if you choose to revise the records.

A/I: The vast majority of A/I records need to be revised. Most prints in fact contain multiple works, so frequently an A/I record must be edited into a collection record and individual entries for each work are needed. A/I is already in the online catalog.

Revise me!

B/I to 1550: The vast majority of B/I records up to the year 1550 need to be revised, including any individual entries that are already attached to the parent record. It is frequently the case that reprints ("following entries") do not have individual entries, while the initial entries (i.e., the prints treated as the first edition in the book) do. These are already in the online catalog.

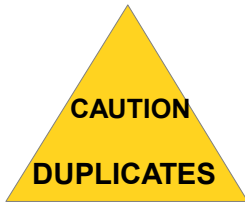

B/I from 1551 to 1700: These records are in Muscat but not in the online catalog because the entries are very rudimentary. They have Muscat numbers that begin with 993. These records must be completely revised and individual entries must be added.

Some imprints were recorded in the B/I series and then again in the A/I series. (In the A/I books, these have **SD** in the entry.)

This means that some imprints have records in Muscat twice, once for each series. In fact, around 1 in 3 B/I records have duplicates in A/I.

If you come across such a case, always **choose to edit the A/I record**. The A/I records are more up-to-date and are already published in the online catalog.

Feel free to copy and paste any relevant information from the B/I record over to the A/I record.

After you have updated the A/I record, **leave a quick comment** in the B/I record. The Central Office will double-check the entry, add any extra holdings, and then delete the B/I record.

Notes such as “Contains..:” can also be added to the A/I entry, but if you are going to create individual records for each work, this is not necessary.

Sometimes the composers are entered as additional names (700). If you add each work as a separate record, 700 entries for each composer are not necessary; if you do not add separate records for each work, then adding such access points would be appreciated by our our RISM users.

Many prints contain multiple works, in which cases individual entries will have to be added. Depending on your time and resources, you may add the individual entries yourself or a later library can add the individual entries.

The following will take you through the Muscat sections one by one, focusing on the fields affected by data imports. Not all fields will be named here. Please refer first and foremost to the Muscat guidelines for each field, as well as the step-by-step guide for cataloging new printed music for more complete information on fields related to printed music.

The example used in this guide is a revision of an A/I record into a collection parent record. Keep in mind that your revision will depend on whether the end result is a collection parent record or an individual entry.

Note: Before you can edit a record for an imprint, your holdings have to be attached to it first! (If you don't know what this means, see the tutorial **Add and edit your holdings to printed music**).

Important first step:

LOOK to see whether a record has already been revised by a RISM national group. There will be a note in the field **Master exemplar (588)** naming the copy used for cataloging and a shelfmark.

In general, **there is no need to re-edit these records**, unless the note indicates that the copy was incomplete (such as title page missing, vla part only, etc.). If your copy is more complete, then you might be able to add elements such as a complete title page transcription. If you do so, add an additional **Master exemplar (588)** note naming your copy.

If there is no note, then the record hasn't been revised and you are free to do so. Add a note and name your copy.

Title and content description (1/3)

- **Title on source (245):** This field always must be completely revised. Titles in the book publications were given in extremely abbreviated form, often with a reference to an earlier edition (this is more easily visible in the online catalog through the "Initial entry" link). Enter a complete title page transcription, including the imprint.
- **Standardized title (240):** Unrevised records frequently have a genre as a standardized title instead of the title. This field must always be revised. The genre can be moved to the field **Subject heading (650)**.
- **Scoring summary (240):** Scoring summaries, when they can be given at all, should only consist of a maximum of four elements. Scoring summaries from imported data frequently are not in line with current RISM standards and almost always have to be revised.

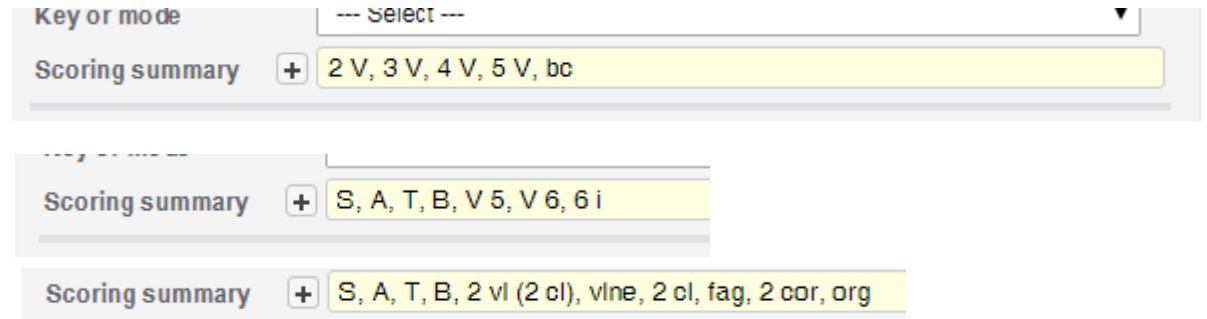

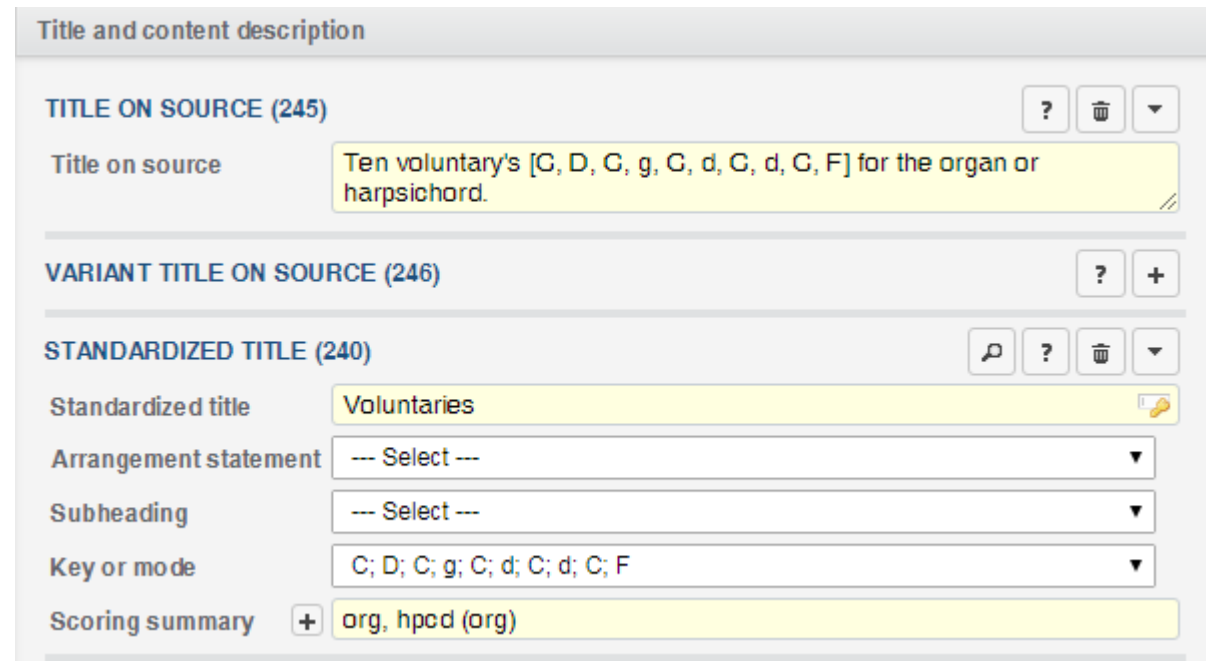

Prints containing more than one work frequently have multiple keys in the fields **Title on source** and **Key or mode**.

Such information belongs in the records for the individual works, so delete it from the title field. (But add it as a note if you elect not to add records for individual works.)

Remove the string of keys from the **Key or mode** field (select **---Select---**).

Bonus tip: Alternate scorings should be expressed by repeating the field.

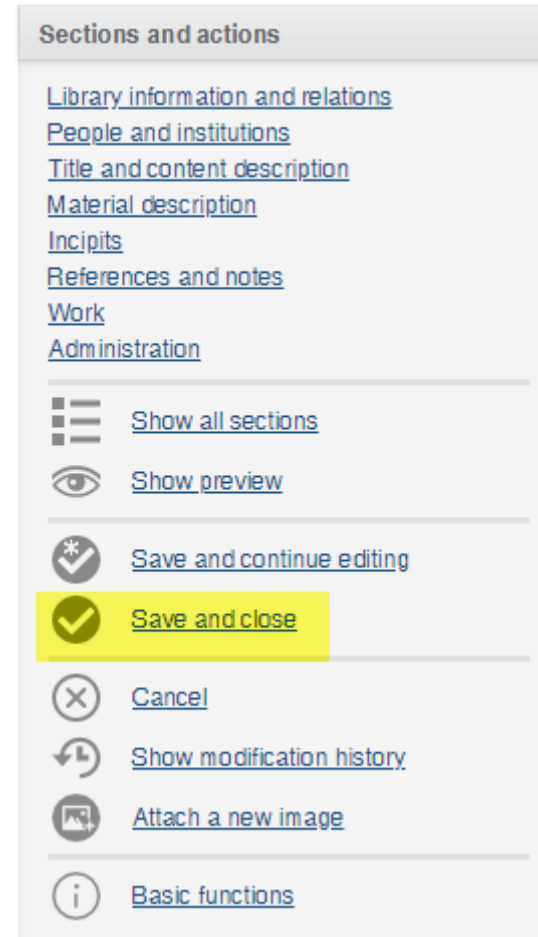

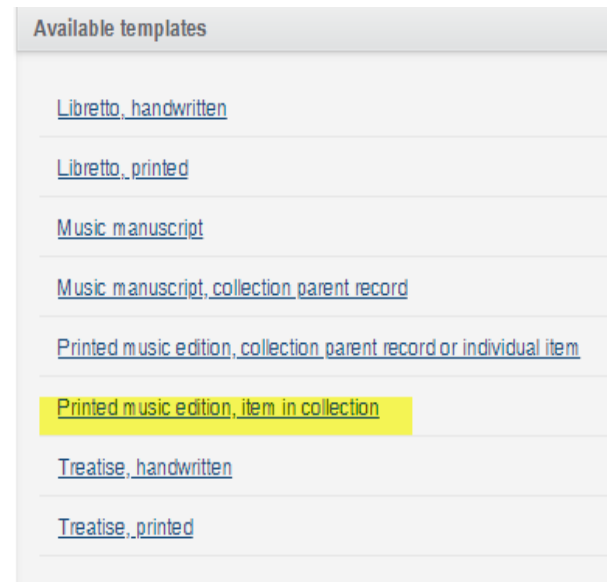
Next steps:

- Add or edit your library's holdings information. Imported records frequently only have the siglum. Please add at least the shelfmark. You can also add other copy-specific information, such as stamps, names of former owners, link to a digitized copy, etc.

- If you revise a B/I record that begins with 993 (these are from B/I, 1551 to 1700) leave it unpublished but add a quick comment to the record saying the record has been revised (save the record, then go to the bottom under "Comments"). Central Office staff will look at the record and we will publish it.
- If you have revised a record for an anthology, you may also add records for the individual works, including incipits. Use the template for the **item in collection**. (Bonus tip: Or modify an existing record by using the duplicate function.) Such additions are very welcome but not required. Any RISM contributor may add the individual entries to a collection record.
