



Muscat: Imprints

- At the moment: you can only add holding records to existing bibliographic records
- Project together with Dresden SLUB
- MARC field definitions completed
- Next step: Installation in Muscat and test version
- Development planned by the beginning of 2018

- National Library of Spain (Madrid) asap
- National Library of Austria (Vienna) 2019
- Series B/I 2nd part / perhaps Series B/II

RISM online catalog

- 1,077,915 records
- 965,471 records on manuscripts
- 165,307 records for printed music (112,444 A/I and B/I)
- 6,329 mixed
- 35,767 links to digital figures
- Records from 44 countries

OPAC: New release 2017/18

- Grant was accepted
- Improvements proposed from survey (some just now)
- Function for comments
- Better integration of RISM authority files
- Links to external content via GND or VIAF
- Improvement of display and search function of imprints
